Program Structure

- The program consists of 10 fortnightly workshops, of 4 hour duration, across 20 weeks
- Programs are conducted over time to allow effective application of concepts, skills, and knowledge
- Workshops enable networking with like-minded Leaders who share common issues and challenges
- Workshops include work-based activities for practical, workplace application, driving improvement
